UNITED WAY / SHARE LIFE

The Milne Company continues its long-standing tradition of encouraging employees to contribute to United Way and/or Share Life in the communities where we work by matching all employee contributions dollar-for-dollar. RETIREMENT PLAN

The Company is a member of the “Northwest Associated General Contractors Chapters 401(k) Profit Sharing Plan”. This plan offers a defined contribution plan, which receives the Company’s contribution, and a 401(k) plan for employee contribution via payroll deduction.


